

## **Global Village Consulting Inc. Releases Open Source GVC.SiteMaker 4.0**

**Vancouver, BC, April 1, 2006 – Global Village Consulting has released the 4.0 major update to GVC.SiteMaker – a very powerful, yet easy-to-use tool for creating custom websites. New features include streamlined editing of text/image sections, a new Mixed Media type section, login/logout links, and the ability to copy a single section.**

GVC.SiteMaker is a web application that empowers non-technical users to create highly customized websites and web databases. It comes with an extensive distributed management architecture tailored for academic settings, which allows schools, colleges, departments, laboratories and other local units to have full control and responsibility for their materials.

GVC.SiteMaker is extremely flexible yet requires no training or experience with HTML. In addition, GVC.SiteMaker is designed to overcome the practical difficulties that people face when trying to put their pages into production. It transparently handles finding the right directory to deposit files, designing layouts and navigation tools, and making pages and files accessible to selected visitors. GVC.SiteMaker also allows either distributed or central administrative control of websites (such as creating and naming them) depending on the needs of the organization.

GVC.SiteMaker is an Open Source project released under the Educational Community License. The source code and binary distributions for GVC.SiteMaker are hosted by SourceForge.net under the project name GVC.SiteMaker.

GVC.SiteMaker was started at University of Michigan (UM), where there are currently over 4,800 sites published, serving such diverse purposes as Interactive Teaching Tools, Lab Websites, Public Service, Lecture and Seminar Series Calendars, and many others that are not served by highly stereotyped services (like course management systems). GVC.SiteMaker is also being used extensively by the Ann Arbor Public Schools (<http://www.aaps.k12.mi.us/>) and the Holland Christian Schools (<http://www.hollandchristian.org/>)

Built using Apple technology, GVC.SiteMaker is being promoted by Apple Computer Inc. to their Educational Customers as part of Apple Canada Inc.'s solution offerings.

According to SourceForge.net's statistics, since its release last May, there have been more than 1,300 downloads of GVC.SiteMaker.
